Dear Opens Doors Friends and Donors,

While the pandemic forced us to deeply consider the fundamental importance of home as a sanctuary from the storm, changes in the economy in 2022 have forced us to ponder the value we place on community, of togetherness and of the strength of our industry.

As leaders in the real estate finance industry, we know that maintaining a commitment to keeping families with sick or injured children in their homes, is not only a strong personal belief, but also is an integral part of our corporate culture.

As vulnerable families continue to withstand the worst of the economic downturn, our industry too has had to adjust. But through the turmoil, our thoughts continued to be with families for whom the stability of home was threatened. How would families with critically ill or injured children, already weary from dealing with so much, be able to cope with yet more uncertainty and worry?

We knew we could help; we knew we had to step forward with strength.

In 2022, we crossed an unimaginable threshold — more than 10,000 families helped in 10 years through our Home Grant Program and a network of 13 children's hospitals in eight states and the District of Columbia. We provided over 3,000 grants — more than we provided during the first eight years of the Foundation combined — nearly \$5 Million in housing assistance in 2022.

Since 2012, you have helped families from every state stay in their homes while their child was in treatment. Thanks to you, keeping families with sick kids in their homes is one of the most meaningful things our industry does.

In 2022, demand for our Home Grant Program grew, so did the ranks of our donors and the capacity of our industry for kindness and compassion. Longtime donors stepped up their support. New donors joined in with extraordinary gifts. MBA member companies launched campaigns that harnessed the creativity of their staffs, uniting people from coast to coast under a single mission.

These remain tough times, but it is important to reflect on the good we have done for so many families in 2022. This year has revealed so much more about the abundant kindness of so many in the real estate finance industry and our communities are stronger together for it.

None of the Foundation's work would be possible without the solid and reliable support of individuals and companies who believe in supporting families in the communities in which they live and work. None of this would be possible without your generosity and your goodwill. We are deeply grateful.

Thank you for all you have done to help families with sick and injured children across America.

ABOUT THE FOUNDATION

Our Story

Committed to helping families around the country stay in their homes while a child is being treated for a critical illness or injury, the Mortgage Bankers Association (MBA) established the MBA Opens Doors Foundation (Opens Doors) to help families in need meet their mortgage and rental obligations.

Founded in 2011, Opens Doors launched its signature Home Grant Program in 2012. The program provides mortgage and rental payment assistance to families with a critically ill or injured child, allowing parents and guardians to be by a child's side during treatment.

In early 2012, the Foundation was granted 501(c)(3) status and began disbursing grants monthly. By the end of that year, 37 grants were made to families through a relationship with Children's National Medical System in Washington, DC. The relationship connected Opens Doors with social workers who work directly with families in need, facilitating an application process that has resulted in more than 10,000 grants and more than \$17 Million provided to needy families.

In 2013, Debra W. Still, CMB, President and CEO of Pulte Financial Services, LLC was named the Foundation's Chairman of the Board and thus started a period of significant growth. In 2014, the Foundation added rental assistance to broaden its reach and provide assistance to families in danger of losing their rental homes because of the financial impact of caring for a child with complex medical needs.

Today, the Foundation's hospital network has grown to 13 hospitals in eight states and the District of Columbia. The number of grants provided per month often exceed the annual number of grants provided in all of 2016.

In 2022, the Foundation celebrated the 10th Anniversary of its Home Grant Program, the vehicle by which the Foundation provides mortgage and rental payment assistance grants to families in need.

Our work would not be possible without the generous support of the MBA, which pays 100% of the Foundation's administrative and operational expenses, so that every dollar donated goes to a family in need of housing assistance.

Our Mission

What We Do

One of the most trying times in a family's life is when a child is critically ill or has suffered a devastating injury. The toll is both emotional and financial, and can lead to a destabilizing home life, especially when a family's home is in jeopardy.

Through its Home Grant Program, Opens Doors provides financial relief in a time of personal crisis. Since awarding its first grants in 2012, the Foundation's Home Grant Program has quickly become a critical part of a family's support structure, especially when a parent or guardian must take unpaid leave to be with a child.

When the coronavirus pandemic hit the United States, millions of families with critically ill or injured children were thrown into turmoil. No one was prepared to endure a protracted shut down of our way of life, least of all prepared to handle the restrictions placed on families with children in treatment for complex medical issues. Families just getting by found themselves on the brink of emotional and financial default.

Those on the front lines were exhausted and without answers to the many questions families had about their child's care and their family's safety.

Today, while we may celebrate the notion that the worst of the pandemic has past, we know that it lingers on and scars from it remain. We know that more work needs to be done to help families with critically ill or injured children.

In 2022, Opens Doors accelerated its Home Grant Program, creating operational efficiencies and a new web-based application system to make it easier for social workers to apply for support on behalf of their patient families.

We raised nearly \$4.5M from individuals and organizations in the real estate finance industry to support a strategic plan that will see Opens Doors expand to different parts of the United States, accommodate new grant programs to help more struggling families, and elevate our standing among charities whose impact is deeply felt by those who most need our support.

More than 5,000 individual and corporate donors have joined with the Foundation's board of directors since the inception of Opens Doors, providing financial support, organizing fundraisers, and building awareness of the Foundation's good work and the families it serves.

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Our Vision

Supporting families across America. Our vision is a world where families with sick children receive mortgage or rental payment assistance while a child is in treatment, allowing parents and guardians to focus on the medical needs of a child rather than on a home in jeopardy.

Our Hospital Network by the Numbers

Today the MBA Opens Doors Foundation has helped over 11,000 families from 50 states, the District of Columbia and Guam, and disbursed more than \$17 million in housing assistance. Community Champion Award

The MBA Opens Doors Foundation is pleased to present the 2022 MBA Opens Doors Community Champion Award to Radian Group, Inc. and Rick Thornberry, CEO. Our awardee has demonstrated outstanding leadership and commitment to the Foundation.

The Community Champion award, created in 2013, recognizes an individual, group or company that has dedicated considerable time and effort to advance the Foundation's mission.

For more than 12 years, Radian has been the lead sponsor of Concert MBA, a benefit concert and auction for Opens Doors. The company and its employees have held numerous special campaigns to support the Opens Doors Foundation and in 2019, committed \$400,000 over four years to support bringing the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia into the Foundation's hospital network.

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In 2020, when the Foundation saw a significant increase in the need for support, Radian stepped up its giving, donating an additional \$50,000, on top of its more than \$160,000 contributed through its Everyday Heroes Challenge. In 2021, Radian added \$171,000 in donations, bringing its total giving to more than \$800,000.

The award recognizes significant contributions to the Foundation's mission of helping vulnerable families with critically ill or injured children remain in their homes while a child is in treatment. The award recognizes individuals whose demonstrated action has occurred over a sustained period of time and whose personal commitment to the Foundation exemplifies the core values, spirit, and essence on which Opens Doors was founded.



As the founder of QuestSoft Corporation, a leading provider of compliance software and services for the real estate finance industry, which was purchased by Ncontracts in 2020, Len infused his and Mary's personal belief in giving back into a QuestSoft corporate culture, donating generously as individual and corporate donors to the Opens Doors mission.

In 2020, after selling QuestSoft to Ncontracts, Len and Mary, through the Eagle Quest Charitable Fund, committed \$500,000 over five years to Opens Doors, support that allowed the Foundation to create the Pandemic Relief Fund, which doubled the Foundation's support to families during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Spirit Award

The MBA Opens Doors Foundation is pleased to present the Spirit Award to the National Mortgage Insurance Corporation (National MI).

National MI has long been committed to giving support to organizations and charities doing good work in communities across the country. In 2019, the company conceived of a program that would tie its corporate performance to charitable giving to Opens Doors, establishing the \$.20 for 20 Campaign, which gave Opens Doors \$.20 for every new loan insured in 2020.

In 2021 and 2022, National MI continued its annual support with \$.21 for 21 and \$.22 for 22 campaigns, providing Opens Doors with a steady and consistent corporate donation that allowed the Foundation to expand its support during the pandemic and to continue to explore new ways of supporting families with critically ill or injured children today.

Since launching their annual campaigns, National MI has donated more than \$121,000 to Opens Doors and helped to expand the Foundation's awareness and mission across its employee and customer bases.

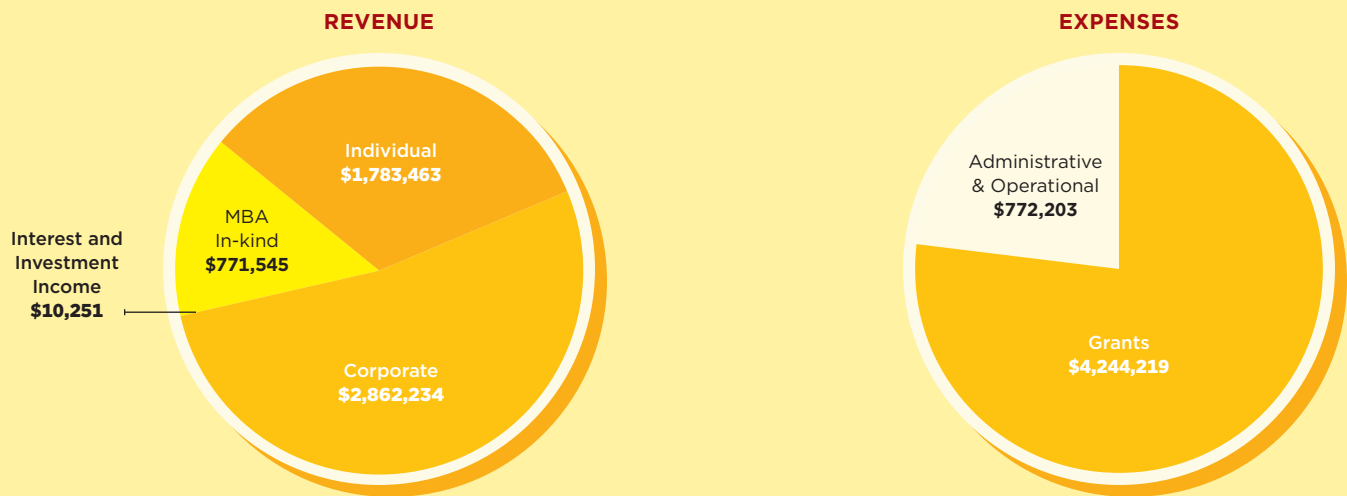

FY 2021, Year Ending Sept. 30, 2021

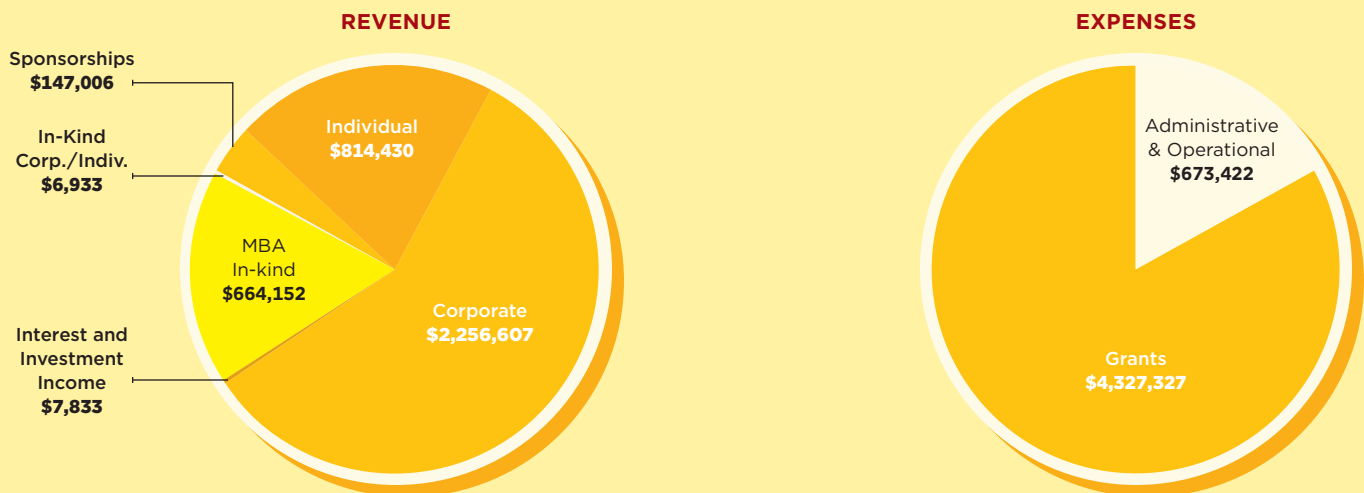
Net assets, as of September 30, 2021: **\$6,199,141**. Figures reflect 2021 audited financials.

CARLOS ROLON

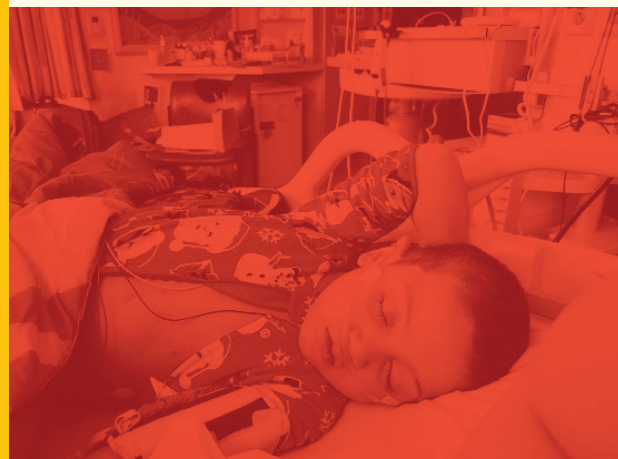
SIX YEARS OLD • MOM: SHEENA COSSETTE
BOSTON CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL

Six-year old Carlos was a frequent flier at Boston Children's Hospital for many years. He spent nearly four years on a heart transplant list, spending nearly 200 days in the hospital before one became available. Prior to his transplant, Carlos' situation was critical and declining as each day without a new heart passed. Carlos' mom, Sheena, worked multiple jobs to make ends meet, but saw her hours cut dramatically when she needed to be in the hospital by Carlos' side. Balancing expenses, including extra travel costs and out of pocket medical expenses while also caring for two other children in the home was extremely difficult.

In April 2020, Carlos received a new heart. He continues to make a full recovery at home.

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I want to thank you for blessing my family with the generous grant you gave me and for helping my family. HADLEY MCMAHON

4 MONTHS OLD • PARENTS: AMBER & GARY
COLORADO CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL

Four month old Hadley was hospitalized for respiratory failure and altered mental status. As a result, an MRI was completed which showed a Posterior Fossa mass lesion. Following a surgical resection and biopsy the lesion was found to be a Medullary Glioma high grade IV. Given this diagnosis and Hadley's progressive clinical decline, an urgent trial of systemic chemotherapy was recommended. Hadley's likelihood of long-term cure from her disease is significantly diminished by the unresectable location of her tumor. The medical treatment plan called for a cycle of carboplatin and etoposide, with an MRI to follow.

Hadley's parents, Amber and Gary exhausted their paid leave after Hadley. Gary quit his job after Hadley was discharged to care for her at home. During her hospital admission, Amber and Gary drove over 80 miles daily to care for Hadley in the hospital and her brother at home.

3 MONTHS OLD • PARENTS: COLE AND JENN
BOSTON CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL

Parker was born with EA/TEF and had surgery on his second day of life. He was hospitalized for over two weeks and was discharged with an NG tube and feeding pump. Parker's parents, Cole and Jenn, have taken unpaid leave and lost income. Cole is uncertain when he will be able to return to work due to Parker's complex care needs. They report increased gas and medical expenses.

NICHOLAS

16 YEARS OLD • BOSTON CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL

Nicholas has a very complex medical history including congenital kyphosis, epilepsy, obstructive sleep apnea and many more serious conditions. His recent hospitalization was to perform a posterior spinal fusion. Nicholas has two siblings also being treated for complex medical and behavioral issues which has stretched the family's resources. The family relies on one income which is supplemented by overtime which is infrequent given the needs of the children at home.



ISLA ROSE VANGEL

THREE YEARS OLD

PARENTS: RACHEL ALFORD AND JAMES VANGEL

Isla Rose has a rare genetic syndrome called Jeune Syndrome, in which her ribs do not grow on pace with her body. As a result, Isla's lungs do not function properly. Twice a year, Isla travels from her home in Northern California to Children's Hospital of Philadelphia to receive surgeries that expand her ribs (VEPTR). After numerous surgeries, Isla has a tracheostomy tube and is dependent on a ventilator. She requires around the clock care and has been hospitalized for the majority of her life. After Isla was born, her father left his job to care for her. Her mother had to reduce her employment and takes unpaid leave for long periods of time.

LYAM McDONALD

5 MONTHS OLD • PARENTS: TY AND JYLL
COLORADO CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL

Before birth Lyam was diagnosed with hypoplastic left heart syndrome, unbalanced AV canal, and aortic stenosis. At just five days old he had his first surgery, a Norwood procedure. In the months that followed, Lyam underwent diaphragm plication surgery, g-tube surgery, a cath lab procedure, and a second open heart surgery. He is still intubated from the last heart surgery (a Glenn procedure) and recovering in the hospital.

With his extensive treatment and surgeries, Lyam's parents, Ty and Jyll, have lost income. Ty is self-employed and not able to work as much because Lyam is hospitalized out of state and he is needed to care for their other child at home. Jyll took an unpaid leave of absence from work and exhausted her medical and paid time off. Their insurance premiums have more than doubled each month.

CLAIRE PECHEK

5 MONTHS OLD • PARENTS: TONY & KATHERINE
COLORADO CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL

Claire is the surviving twin of an extremely premature birth. Her twin, Kirsten, did not survive. Claire spent 152 days in the NICU and now has a feeding tube for nutrition and extensive early intervention therapies. Claire's older sister, Maggie, also has special medical needs requiring extra care.

Claire's mother is the primary income earner in the household. Due to bedrest prior to the birth of the twins, plus Claire's prolonged hospitalization after birth, Katherine took over three months of unpaid leave. Claire's father, Tony, picked up a second job in order to make up for at least part of their lost income. Claire's prolonged care resulted in increased travel, food, and medical expenses.

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Thank you so much for awarding our family a mortgage payment for the month of December. We are so grateful for organizations like yours as we work toward rebuilding and re-saving. Thank you again and Happy Holidays to all!

LEILA

3 YEARS OLD • BOSTON CHILDREN'S

Leila was prenatally diagnosed with a congenital diaphragmatic hernia. She is medically complex due to being trach and vent dependent. She also suffers from a brain injury, epilepsy, heart defects and other severe conditions. Following Leila's birth her mother lost her full time job and as a single mother is the sole support for Leila. They moved in with Leila's grandmother to help reduce living expenses until her grandmother unexpectedly passed away. Leila's mother works as she is able but is incurring significant expenses related to Leila's care.



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MELODY

3 MONTHS OLD • COOK CHILDREN'S

At just 30 weeks gestation, Melody was born without a heartbeat and had to be resuscitated. As a result, she was diagnosed with hydrocephalus due to the brain trauma and has been through two brain surgeries. Melody was hospitalized with no discharge date planned. One parent is not working to help care for Melody resulting in a significant loss of income along with increased out-of-pocket expenses which are no longer covered.



To the MBA Opens Doors Foundation,

This is a long overdue thank you email. Your foundation paid for our family's mortgage for the month in June 2019. Last year, my oldest daughter, Madeline had life-saving abdominal surgery at Boston Children's Hospital. She was rushed to Children's from our local hospital, septic and on a ventilator, from complications caused by a rare diagnosis (wandering spleen and malrotation of intestines) likely due to her connective tissue disorder (periventricular nodular heterotopia, or PVNH). It all hit us like a bolt of lightning on a cloudless day: she went from a healthy, exuberant young child to being on death's door in a matter of a couple days. By the time she got to Boston Children's in the early morning hours of Sunday, April 21, 2019, my husband and I were told "her life is hanging in the balance." We said our goodbyes to her and told her to keep fighting just before she was whisked away to the OR. I cannot express the relief we felt when a OR nurse told us about an hour into the surgery, "she's doing great." We were fortunate to have a rockstar surgical team on call that night. After the surgery was over, and Maddie was stabilized in the ICU, we embraced the surgeon, Dr. Terry Buchmiller and the anesthesiologist Dr. Seefelder. Everyone was hugely relieved.

Some of my family members are Christians, and on that Easter Sunday, my uncle told the congregation, "today, our family celebrates two resurrections".

Maddie was in the hospital for 2 weeks and celebrated her 5th birthday at Children's. The surgeon was able to save part of her spleen, which will hopefully regain functioning some day. She's made a dramatic recovery and is doing really well in Kindergarten. She just celebrated her 6th birthday.

Her younger sister, Amelia, also had lifesaving surgery at Boston Children's Hospital at just 2-months-old (in September 2018) for a VSD that required open heart surgery.

During these uncertain and scary times, our hearts go out to all the families who have loved ones in the hospital and all the doctors, nurses and other medical staff on the frontlines.

Our family has learned to enjoy life one day at a time, to keep our focus on the bigger picture and remain hopeful.

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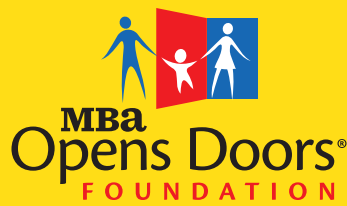
